

Easter brings together the Christian community in worship and celebration, emphasizing unity in Christ and the shared experience of faith and resurrection.

Divine Mercy

Particularly highlighted on the Second Sunday of Easter, also known as <u>Divine Mercy Sunday</u>, this theme focuses on God's infinite mercy and love, inviting believers to trust in Jesus' message of mercy and to act mercifully towards others.



✓ DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET


